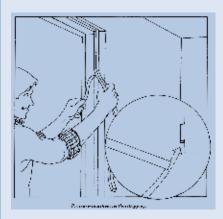
SHOP AND SAVE...THE PLANET!

WEATHERSTRIPS FOR WINTER



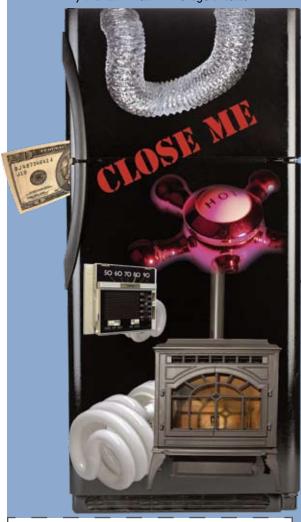
Windows can be cold air culprits when the temperature goes down, so now is a good time to make sure your windows keep that toasty air inside. An easy and cheap way is to seal them with weather-stripping. Measure your windows and buy the appropriate amount of weather-stripping. Remember to install it along the sashes and the sashframe tops and bottoms. Carefully follow the manufacturer's instructions to get the most effective insulation bang for your buck, and recheck your

weather-stripping every year as it does wear out over time. Paired it with caulking, and you'll save a bundle on energy this winter!
